

How to get Zoledronic acid infusion?

Brand-specific infusion programs provide infusion services at no additional charge. There are many clinics across the province you could select from. The infusion program coordinates your infusion appointment. You can fill the prescription at your own pharmacy. Infusion of Zoledronic acid 5mg is not offered at the Calgary hospitals or at the osteoporosis centre.

Step 1: Get Zoledronic acid 5mg prescription from your physician. Any necessary insurance paperwork should be completed by your physician. Decide if you are getting generic (approx. \$400) or brand name (approx. \$800).

Step 2: Register yourself into an infusion program and request an infusion appointment. You will need to provide your physician's name and contact info. For generics, phone Infuze at 1-877-767-2260. For brand Aclasta, phone For My Bones at 1-877-580-5338.

Step 3: Ensure you have the infusion clinic's phone number and address. Call Infuze (generics) or For My Bones (brand name) to clarify if you don't have that info.

Step 4: Fill your prescription and take Zoledronic acid 5mg to your infusion appointment.

The above steps must be completed for each infusion. Infusion programs do not send out reminders. It is your responsibility to contact your physician for prescription renewal.
